Dear Parent,

It's a great pleasure to connect with you again. A lot has changed over the last one year. Now, we stand on the verge of a new norms where the lockdown has gradually been lifted after the second wave of Covid 19. It is our responsibility to be self-reliant, maintain community health and education of our children most importantly to get vaccinated ourselves.

As per the guidelines issued by UP Govt. through DIOS, Ghaziabad students of the Classes IX to XII have been allowed to visit the school for taking guidance from their teachers for remediation. Since we are beginning our classes in phases, students of Classes IX will be called in the first phase w.e.f. **Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2021.**

In the wake of the school opening on **Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2021**, the school is taking following precautionary measures in order to prevent the spread of the coronavirus among their students, staff, and communities.

1. Entrance has mandatory hand hygiene (four wash basins with soap). Separate gates will be used to maintain social distancing.
2. The facility of checking temperature (Thermal Screening) is available at gate. In case any student, teacher or other staff member is running temperature, he/she shall not be permitted to attend school under any circumstances. Biometric attendance is completely disabled for the prevention.
3. The use of mask is compulsory for every member of the school inside the School premises. "Proper" positioning of mask on the face is ensured.
4. There is a provision of alcoholic hand sanitizer at the entrance of school building.
5. Prior to resumption of activities, all work areas intended for teaching/demonstrations etc., including laboratories, other common utility areas are regularly sanitized with 1% sodium hypochlorite solution, with particular attention to frequently touched surfaces.
6. Housekeeping employees have been trained about norms for waste management & it's safe disposal.
7. Safe distance of minimum 2 m is maintained with everyone. No stranger is permitted in school premises.
8. Limited number of students will be allowed to sit in a class room. Spacious Multipurpose Hall will be used if number of students is more.
9. Full-time trained health care attendant and counsellor will take care of physical and mental health of the students
10. No food or open drink containers are permitted. Sharing of food and water is not permitted.
11. Any shared equipment/sitting place within the lab/sitting is thoroughly sanitized after use (an alcohol solution can be used) to avoid interpersonal contamination. It is imperative that hands be washed before and after any instrument usage.
12. Students will be allotted their individual seats, duly displayed in seating plan. Changing of seats is not permitted.
13. No outsider are allowed to enter the building/lab without mask. All members will maintain safe distance of 6 feet.
14. All Teaching, Non-Teaching and other helping staff have received at least one dose of vaccination.

## SEATING PLAN

- As suggested by the Ministry of Health, there must be at least 6 feet distance between students in the revised seating plan. It is advisable to mark the seating that students should occupy.
- Limited number of students will be allowed in a classroom.
- Seating will be arranged keeping in view physical/social distancing of 6 feet and one child one bench norm' will be considered. Similarly, physical/social distancing shall also be maintained in the staff rooms, office area, and other places of public interaction.
- Outdoor spaces (in case of pleasant weather) will be utilized for conducting classes, keeping in view the safety and security of the children and physical distance protocols
- Seats will be designated with adequate distance for teachers in the staff room and other available rooms/halls.

## SAFETY NORMS FOR STUDENTS IN SCHOOL

- The students will arrive at school wearing a face cover/mask and continue wearing it all through, especially when in class, or doing any activity in groups, working in the laboratories or reading in the libraries.
- Simple health screening of students and staff may be carried out daily, and updates will be maintained.
- Every child needs to learn how to cough or sneeze into a tissue or elbow and avoid touching face, eyes, mouth, and nose. Children will be trained for the same.
- Availability of necessary equipment like gloves, face cover/ masks, hand washing soaps for sanitation staff/workers.
- Task force of teachers will on rotation basis to monitor observing of physical /social distancing norms at different places and also students' behaviour like frequently touching own face or handshake with other students, etc.

- ☞ The transport facility will be provided to the students who are willing to avail the same on specified routes (as followed on 18/1/2021). The transport charges will be on pro-rata basis. The parents can submit their consent for the same.

**Parents are requested to get themselves & their family members vaccinated at the earliest. Students who have completed the age of 18 years may also be vaccinated.**
